



Rebecca, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harold Zimmerman, received her award from Mrs. Betty Overly, American Legion Auxiliary.

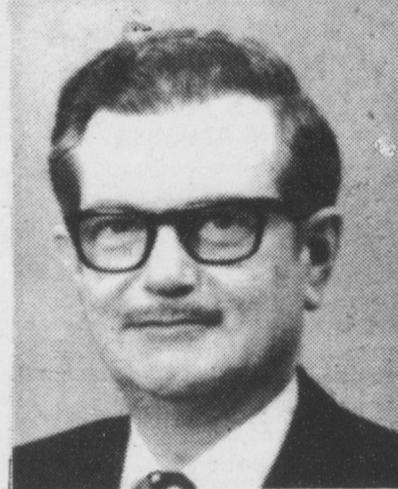
James, son of Mr. and Mrs. John F. Shrum, received his award from Mr. Henry Mccollough, American Legion Commander.
