bethtown College

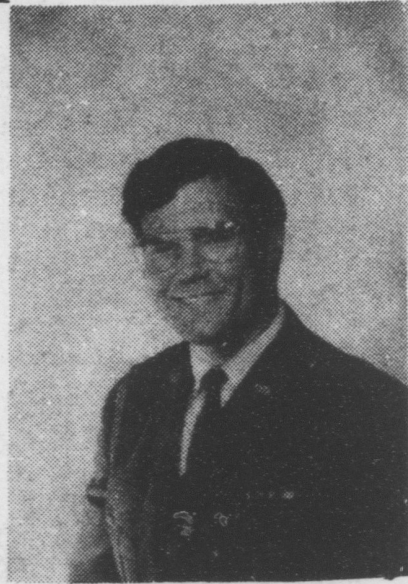
