anymore!"

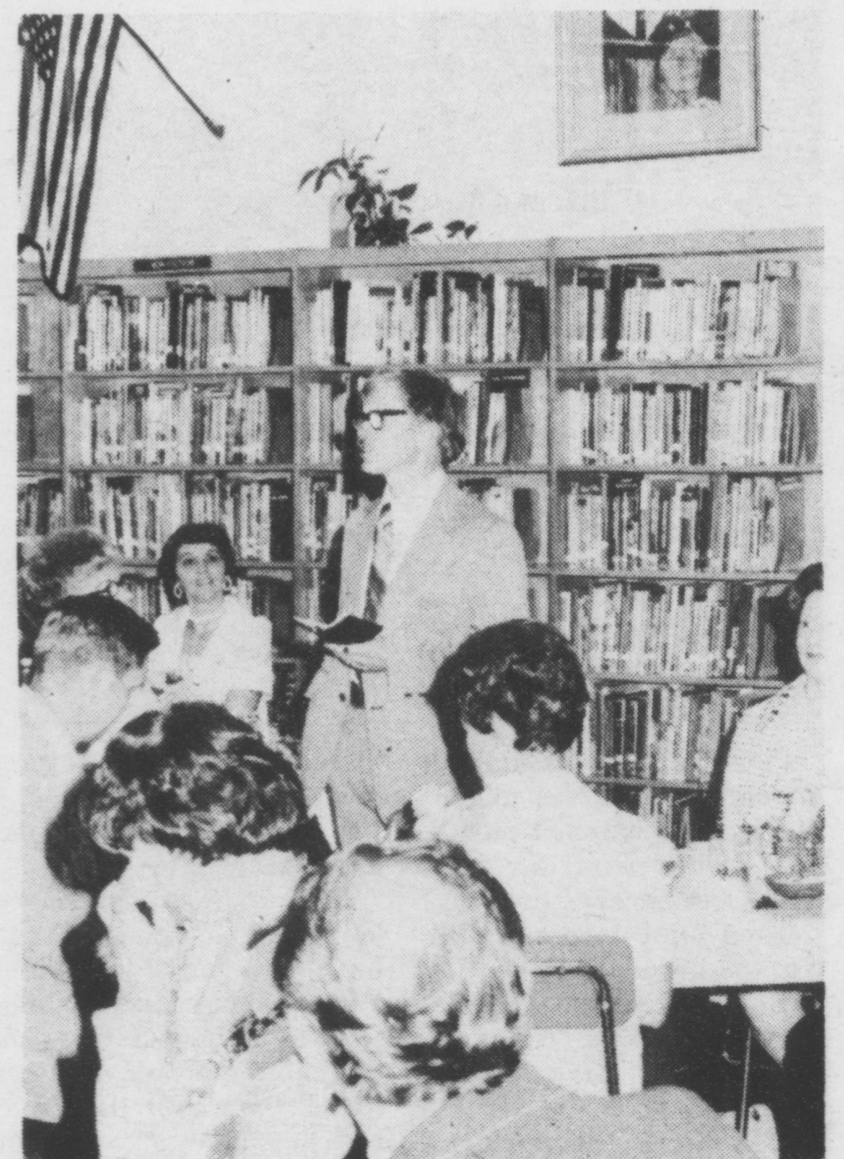
