The Caravan arrived in Bowie on June 22 for a week of intensive training and following a service of dedication June 29 they left immediately for Miami, Florida and Colombia, South America, where from July 3 to 17 they will team with Alliance missionaries in conducting evangelistic open-air services and engaging in Indian Tribes ministry. Services will also be conducted by the youth in some of the Colombian National churches. Upon their return in mid-July, the Caravan will visit many of the Eastern District churches in the four remaining weeks of their summer itinerary.
