"National Register of Historic Places "Registered Historical Landmark" Well informed tour guides explain the many facets of brewing in the upper and lower levels of Lancaster County's oldest brewery. Giant vats are still in place within the Lagering Cellar. The fermented brew was placed in wooden casks in order to age for a period of 30 days before being drawn off into Lunches—11 to 2; Dinners—5 to 9 smaller kegs which were stored 43 feet below the street surface. Temperature remains around 50 de-Monday thru Thursday-5 to 9 grees year around in the Catacombs. Friday and Saturday—5 to 10
