Good, principal at Kraybill Mennonite School, Route 1, Mount Joy was one of the 220 administrators, board members, and teachers from 29 states, three provinces of Canada and five other foreign countries who were attending the fifth National Institute of Christian School Administration held on the Grace College campus in Winona Lake July 28 through August 1.
