# Elizabethtown festival planned

Exhibitors should take note, however, that perishable items will be accepted only between 6 and 9 p.m. on Tuesday.

Judging will be held Wednesday, September 17, and the exhibits will be opened to the public at 6p.m. that evening, when the Festival begins.

Cash premiums will be awarded for the winning entries.

Full details of the Market Place Fair will be included in the Festival pamphlet which will be distributed to some 22,000 homes in a fifteen mile radius of Elizabethtown shortly before the Festival.


Also surviving are 16 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren, and a brother, Clarence Greiner of Elizabethtown.
