The Indians scored twice in the first quarter.

Allan Brooks and Roy Gallagher carried the ball across the line, and George Mohr kicked it between the goal posts, making the score 14-0.

The Indians slowed down a bit in the second quarter. A blocked Indian punt put the Tide on the scoring end of the field. Burke found Eck with a 12 yard pass to the end zone, putting Columbia on the scoreboard with only 23 seconds to go in the first half.

A tricky fake kick did not trick the Donegal defense. At halftime, things still looked rosy for the Indians.

Columbia scored again in the 4th quarter when Burke ran 76 yards for a touchdown. This time the Tide made no pretense about their intention to make 2 extra points. They succeeded, and the score was tied.
