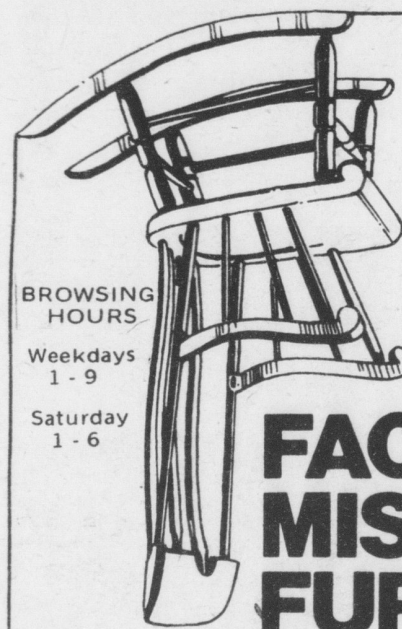

## College Board tests at D.H.S.

The Donegal High School Guidance Department has announced that testing dates, scholarships, and job opportunities are available to DHS students.

The College Board Tests will be given at DHS on Saturday, November 1. Registration to take these tests must be completed before September 26. Registration forms are available in the guidance office.

The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test and National Merit Scholarship Test will be given at DHS on Tuesday, October 21. All juniors are eligible to take this test. It is recommended that those planning to attend an institution of higher education following graduation from Donegal High plan to take it. The charge for taking this test is \$2.50. Register in Mrs. Grimm's office anytime between now and October 10.

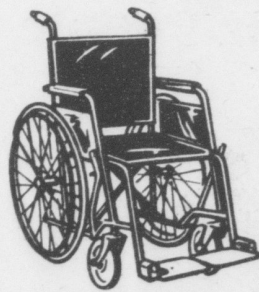

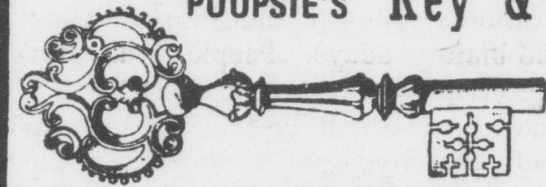
