Noted Bible teacher at Kraybill School

Daniel Yutzy, well known educator and Bible teacher from Eastern Mennonite College, Harrisonburg, Virginia, will address a fund raising banquet sponsored by the Kraybill Mennonite School on September 29. The banquet will be held at 6:45 p.m. at Hostetter Banquet Hall in Mount Joy. The school has planned the banquet to help raise funds to cover the difference between tuition income and actual operating costs. Ticket information is available through the school office.

Kraybill Mennonite began classes on September 3 with a record enrollment of 201 students in Kindergarten through Grade 9. This is an 18 percent increase over last year's enrollment. The students are residents of nine local school districts and come from 117 families representing 41 local con-

gregations. Kindergarten is the largest class with a total of 34 students enrolled in two section.

The school has a staff of 15 teachers, five of whom teach only part time. Leon W. Good is in his third year as school administrator. Three of the teachers have joined the staff for the 1975-76 school year. Mr. Paul Kurtz, a 1975 graduate of Penn State University, is teaching junior high science. Mrs. Linda Hopper, a 1973 graduate of Drexel University and Temple University, is teaching junior high economics part time. Ruth Ramer, a senior at Eastern Mennonite College began a nine-week student teaching experience in Grade 1 and Kindergarten on Monday, September 22. A nine-week course in Black History and Culture has been added to the junior high curriculum.
