

Results of Championship Tourney of Mount Joy Golf Association

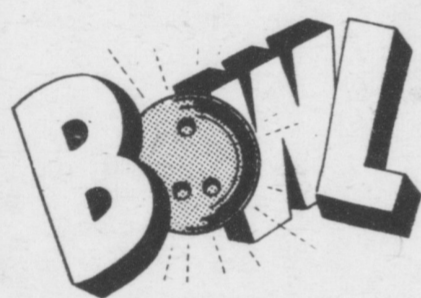
The Mount Joy Golf Association's Championship was held September 14 at Hawk Valley. The Association were then guests at the Central Hotel which sponsored the event.

C. Bell was low gross with 85 and J. Deitz was second low gross with 87. Other players and their net scores are listed below.

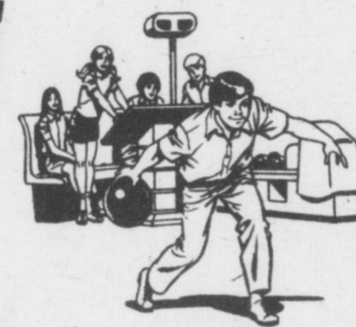
