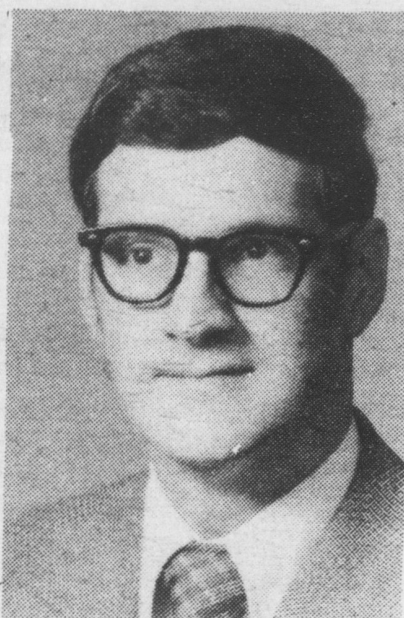
## J-Cettes plan E-town sale

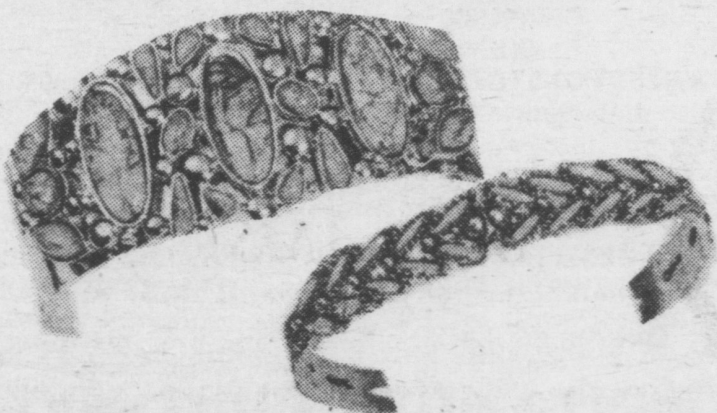

## Rev. Robert Murphy to speak to Lanco Historical Society

Rev. Mr. Robert C. Murphy will present an illustrated lecture, "Colonial Donegal," at the monthly meeting of the Lancaster Historical Society at 8 p.m., Tuesday, October 14.

The minister for the past two years at the Donegal Presbyterian Church, Mount Joy, the Rev. Murphy formerly had served as associate pastor for the Sharon Community Presbyterian Church, Corapolis, Pa., and as assistant minister at the Derry Presbyterian Church, Hershey, Pa.

He received his undergraduate degree from Drexel University and his master's degree of divinity from

the Princeton Theological Seminary.

Last year Mrs. Murphy and he participated in a pilgrimage to Ulster, Ireland, in commemoration of the 300th birthday of the Mother Church in Donegal.

Locally, the Donegal Presbyterian Church, representing the historic seat of Scot-Irish settlement in Lancaster County, is famed for its American Revolutionary War oath of allegiance to the patriot cause.

A social hour with light refreshments will follow the free public meeting. There is adequate parking on the Society's grounds, 230 N. President Ave.

## Attention: H.S. Juniors

Attention all high school juniors planning a college education: The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test will be administered on October 21. The PSAT/NMSQT measures verbal and mathematical aptitude. This test, cosponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation, allows students to enter the competition for National Merit Scholarships and gives them the opportunity

to participate in the College Board's Student Search Service, which is used by hundreds of colleges seeking potential students. Finally, the test can give the student a good idea of what the Scholastic Aptitude Test is like.

Along with their score reports, students will receive a handy booklet with information about estimating SAT scores and how and where to get more detailed information about colleges and financial aid.
