In addition, Mr. Snyder was founder and builder of The Old Forge School for the Handicapped, Delaware County; a charter member of the Pennsylvania Therapeutic Recreation Society; a board member of the Pennsylvania Recreation and Parks Society; and a social worker for Lancaster County. He was elected to Who's Who in the East.
