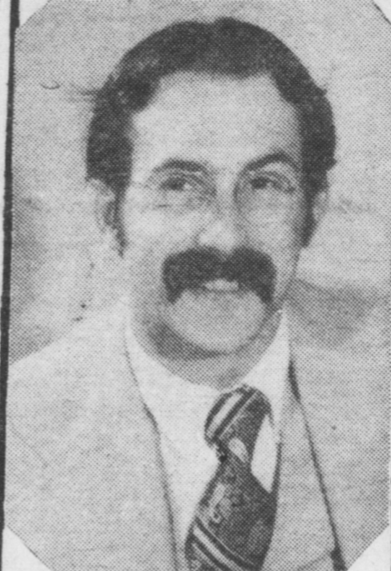
What purpose should a report card serve? Should it be used as a tool for comparing children so that some will emerge as winners and others as losers, or should it help parents to better understand their own child and share in guiding his growth?

The above questions were carefully considered by the report card committee of the Donegal Elementary Schools. This committee, comprised of parents, teachers, and administrators, chose to pursue the latter.

During the 74-75 school year the parents of approximately 180 elementary students received their child's report card which was somewhat different from the traditional card. It stressed the individual's progress rather than comparing him with others. Comments from the field indicated a need for further refinement and development of this type of reporting system.
