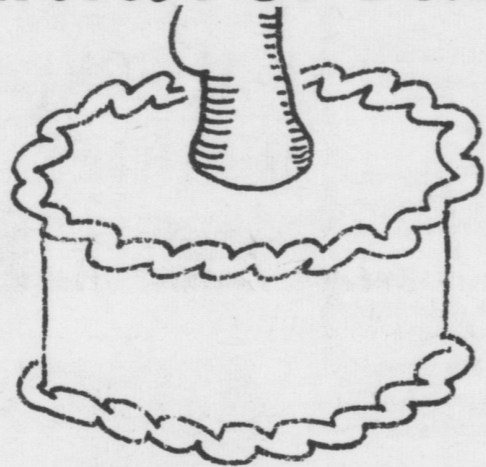

J.V.'s, who were having a good year, lost their last four soccer matches to finish the season with six wins, seven losses, and three ties.

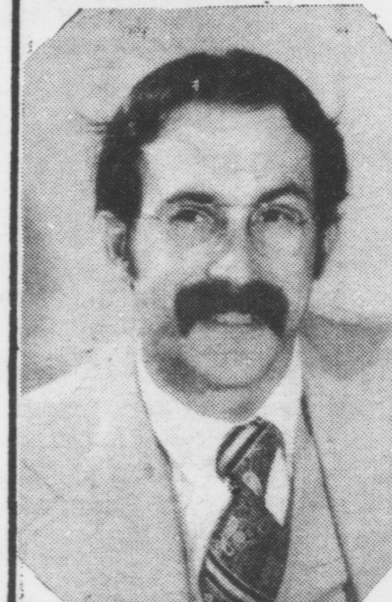
Tennises married 25 years
