Mrs. William Brown, president, announced an

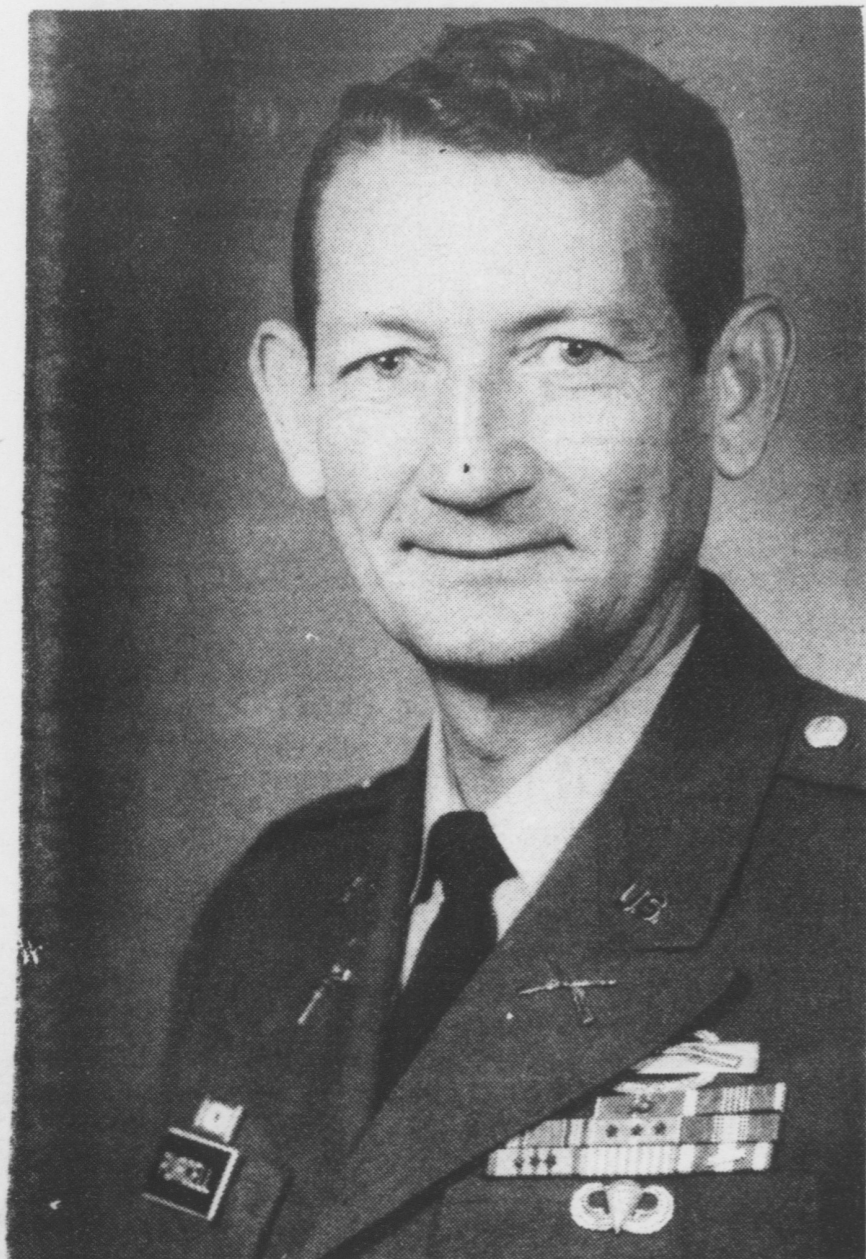

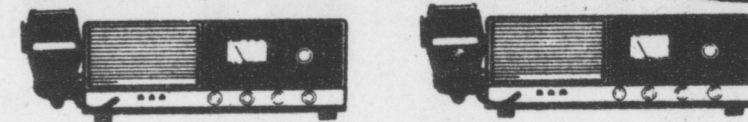

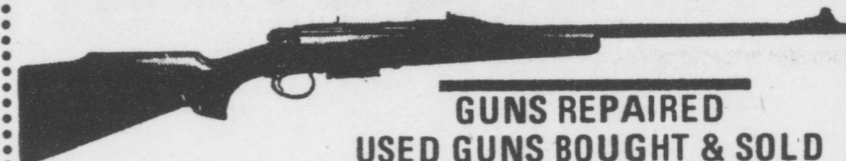
