The Indians began this basketball season by beating Octoraro in Mount Joy.

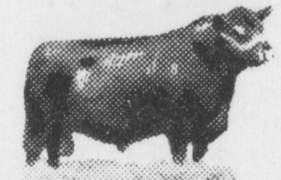
The team dropped their second game to Dallastown, losing 71-84. Dallastown

High scorers for the varsity were Fellenbaum (21 points), Bradley and McCue (16 each) and Miller (12 points).

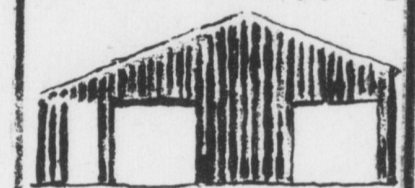
