**ORDINANCE NO. 75-7**  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MARIETTA BOROUGH ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1971 REPEALING SECTION 2202(1) OF SAID ORDINANCE AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 2202(1) AND ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH TO SECTION 2101 BOTH PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR HEARINGS BEFORE THE ZONING HEARING BOARD AND/OR BOROUGH COUNCIL; AND ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH TO SECTION 2203(3) PROVIDING FOR VARIANCES

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Marietta, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

**SECTION I:** The Act of August 10, 1971, known as the Marietta Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1971, is hereby amended by repealing Section 2202(1). Said Section is hereby repealed.

**SECTION II:** The Act of August 10, 1971, known as the Marietta Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1971, is hereby amended by adding the following section:

#### SECTION 2202(1) - PROCEDURE

Appeals to the Zoning Hearing Board may be taken by any person or Borough official aggrieved or affected by any provision of the Zoning Ordinance or by any decision, including any order to stop, cease and desist issued by the Zoning Officer. Such appeals shall be taken within a reasonable time as provided by the Municipalities Planning Code by filing with the Zoning Officer and with the Board a Notice of Appeal specifying the grounds thereof. Upon payment of the fees set out below, the Zoning Officer shall forthwith transmit to the Board all the papers constituting the record upon which the action appealed from was taken. The fee for all matters except an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance (including, but not limited to, requests for variances, special exceptions, and appeals from decisions of the Zoning Officer) shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars. However, the appealing party may be assessed with all costs arising out of the presence of a person authorized to make a stenographic record of the proceedings before the Board. Any such costs for said person taking a stenographic record shall be approximated in advance by the Borough Secretary and said costs shall be paid in advance by the person making the appeal.

**SECTION III:** The Act of August 10, 1971, known as the Marietta Zoning Ordinance of 1971, is hereby amended by repealing the last paragraph of Section 2101 of said Ordinance and adding a new paragraph to Section 2101 as follows:

A fee of Forty (\$40.00)

Dollars shall be paid upon the filing of such Petition for the purpose of defraying the costs of the proceedings thereon. In addition to said fee, the Petitioner may be assessed with all costs arising out of the presence of a person authorized to make a stenographic record of the proceedings before the Board. Any such costs for said person taking a stenographic record shall be approximated in advance by the Borough Secretary and said costs shall be paid in advance by person making the appeal.

**SECTION IV:** The Act of August 10, 1971, known as the Marietta Borough Zoning Ordinance of 1971, is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph to Section 2203(3) as follows:

The procedure set out in Section 2202 of this Ordinance shall govern the consideration of all variances by the Zoning Hearing Board.

**ORDINANCE NO. 376**  
AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A PROPERTY TAX AND A PER CAPITA TAX FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1976. IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

#### SECTION 1

A tax is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough. Subject taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1976 is as follows: tax rate for general purposes, the sum of Thirteen (13) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, making a total tax rate of Thirteen (13) mills for Borough purposes under this section.

#### SECTION 2

In addition to the taxes levied by Section 1 of this Ordinance, a per capita tax of five (\$5.00) dollars for the fiscal year 1976 is hereby levied on each resident of the Borough twenty-one (21) years of age and over. This section is enacted under authority of the Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145, and its amendments.

#### SECTION 3

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 8th day of December 1975.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MARIETTA, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1976

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Marietta, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

**SECTION I.** That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the said Borough of Marietta subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1976 as follows: the tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of Sixteen (16) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION II.** This Ordinance shall become effective when advertised as required by law.
