East Donegal adopts zoning
East Donegal Township's new Municipal Building was on display last Sunday when the supervisors held an Open House.
Visitors were impressed and pleased by the spacious meeting rooms and housing for equipment.
At their regular monthly meeting, last Thursday night, the supervisors Lloyd Fuhrman, Abram Nolt, and James Johnstin, adopted the new zoning law, which implemants the comprehensive plan for the township. The plan has won praise for its provisions permitting gradual housing, commercial, and industrial development near the borough of Marietta and Mount Joy-but preserving the interior of the township for agricultural use.
The supervisors also granted an extension in time for the building of the Country Village (Endslow) Development near Maytown.
