minced lemon rind．Boil all together until quite tender and pulp the apples hrough a sieve；if they should not be quite sweet enough，add a little more agar and put them at the bottom of gether the mill a thiek layer．Stir little sugar，over the fire，and let the alxture thicken，but do not allow it to reach the boiling point．When thick ake it off the fire；let it cool a little， hen pour it over the apples．Whip te．，the same as for other trifles；heap thigh over the custard，and the dish tis as fancy dictates，with stripes of bright apple jelly，slices of eitron etc．
