and witiout a struggle. The exseationer had been most earnestly entrented by doctor of medicine, a professer, to provide him for onco with a "warm corpse." To comply with this wish he shortened thin legnal "eight minutes" for which a crimi-
nal strould hang to three, and havided th corpseo over to a plyysician, who deelared Tabaks to entirely dead. The body was apread upon the marble table in the anatomy room and profensor and students prepared for the dissection, which, had they
been in anything of a hurry, might bavi become vivisection. All of a mudden the body moved, first its feet, and theu its haves, and at last tiembled violently all presence of mind, but ealmly sent to the suthorities to nsk if Tabaks was to be re-
