Management of the Little Folks.

Food for Fat People.

There are three classes of food, the olls, weets, and starches, the special office of shich isto support the animal heat and produce fat, having little or no influence n promotion strength, muscle, or endurance. If fat people, therefore, would use less fat and more of lean meats, fish, and fowl, less of fine flour, and more of the whole product of the grains, except the bull, less of the sweets, particularly in warm weather, and more of fruit acids in a mild form, as in apples, sleep less, be less indolent, and labor more in the open air, the fat would disappear to a certain extent, without no loss of real health. In food we have almost a perfeet control in this matter, far better than in the use of drugs. If we have too such fat and too little muscle, we have mply to use less of the fat forming ints, and more of the muscle food.




