Van Buren played the role of the girl in the casket. "It feels good, I hope it will be beneficial and cause people to realize the penalties of drunken driving. If it helps one person, then it would of done its job," Van Buren said of her involvement in the video.

Officer Todd Allen wrote the script with the intention of spreading awareness to the students. Allen, a member of the college's Health Advisory Board, explained that the story line is intentionally direct so that viewers understand the dangers of driving under the influence.

Allen filed for the grant used to create the video in the spring of 1987. S.A.D.D. was awarded the grant in September 1987 from the Department of Education's Fund for the Improvement of Post Secondary Education. The grant allowed the advisor to film a video last month on designated drivers as well as the video segments.

These segments will also be a

part of S.A.D.D.'s program to present the message of the perils individuals face when they choose to drive drunk or let others drive drunk. The videos will be available as national public service spots as well as to the general public. The segments will also be featured in the annual catalog for the National Clearinghouse for Alcohol and Drug Abuse.

Once the segments have been converted to 16 mm film, the messages will be shown prior to screenings of all movies being shown on campus. Other plans includes the release of a Behavioral Attitude Study triangulating the amounts of referrals, arrests, and dormitory damages due to drunkenness.

Behrend's S.A.D.D. chapter plans to present a strong statement against drunk driving that will enable students as well as the surrounding community to rethink any possible involvement in a drunk driving situation.

## Recognition Offered for **Outstanding Faculty**

Dr. Robert Tauber and Dr. John Gamble are winners of the Excellence in Academic Advising and Excellence in Teaching Awards, respectively.

The Excellence in Teaching Award was initiated in 1969 to recognize the Behrend faculty member who best "fills the roll of an inspired and committed teacher." Any faculty member who has taught full time at Behrend for at least two years is eligible. Gamble, this year's recipient, is a professor of political science.

The Guy W. Wilson Award for Excellence in Academic Advising was established in 1982 to reward the Behrend faculty member who has best aided students with their academic advising, helping them to be successful in school and guiding them to appropriate career choices.
