Behrend Ranger Challenge team goes on the road to Fort Indiantown Gap

On November 4 and 5, the Behrend ROTC Ranger Challenge Team traveled to Fort Indiantown Gap to compete in a state wide military skills competition.

The team was picked up in Erie by an Army "Sky Crane" helicopter. The two hour flight was cold, but much preferred to a seven hour drive.

The events, held on Saturday, consisted of rope bridge, weapons assembly, grenade throw, physical fitness test, land navigation, and marksmanship.

On Sunday the teams competed in the foot blistering six mile road march with

equipment. Thirty-one other teams participated from schools such as Clarion, IUP, University Park, Carnegie Mellon, Pitt, and Valley Forge Military Academy.

Top performances for the Behrend team included a 4th place in rifle marksmanship, and the 7th fastest time in rifle and machine gun assemble.

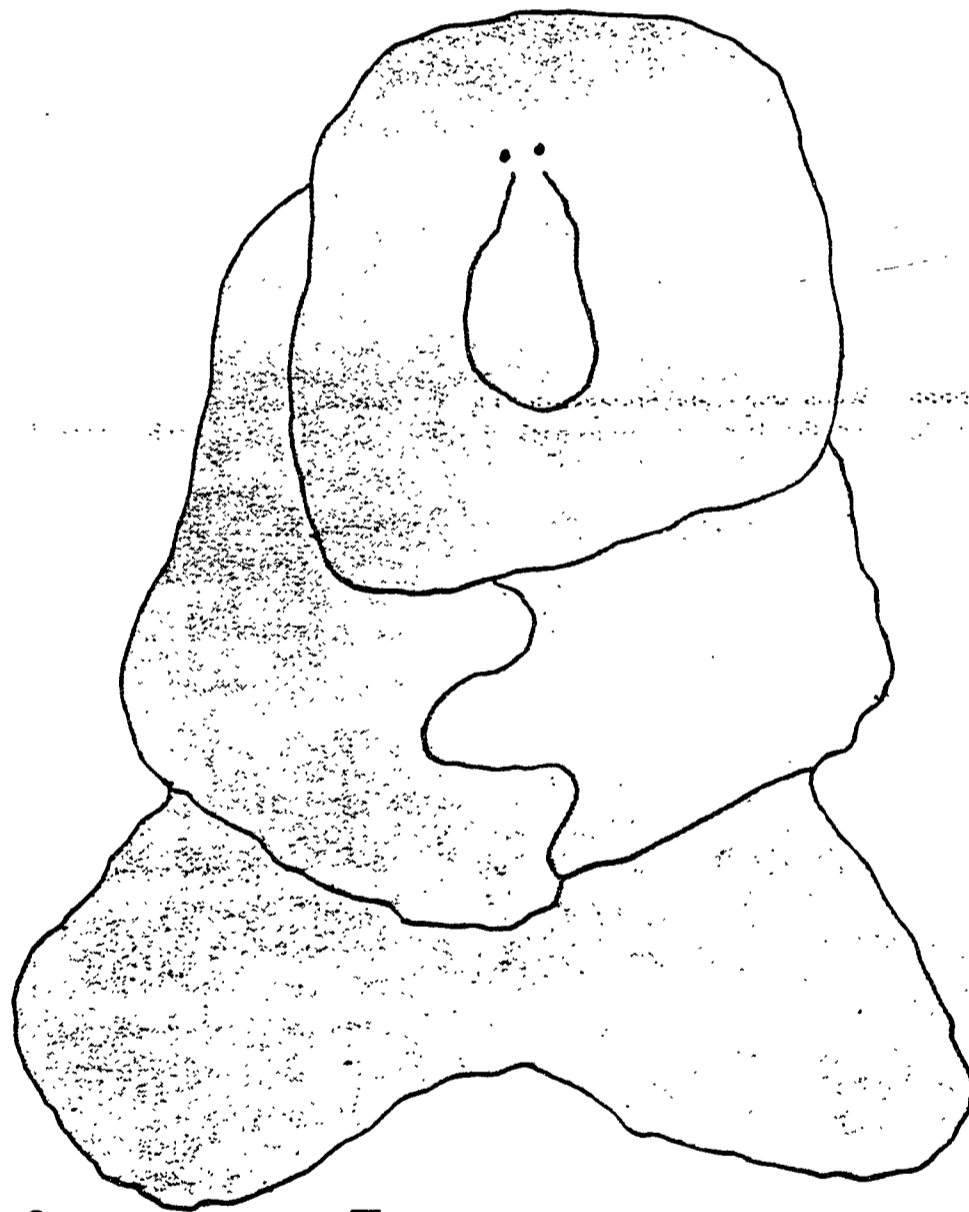
