James Bowen heads Food and Housing

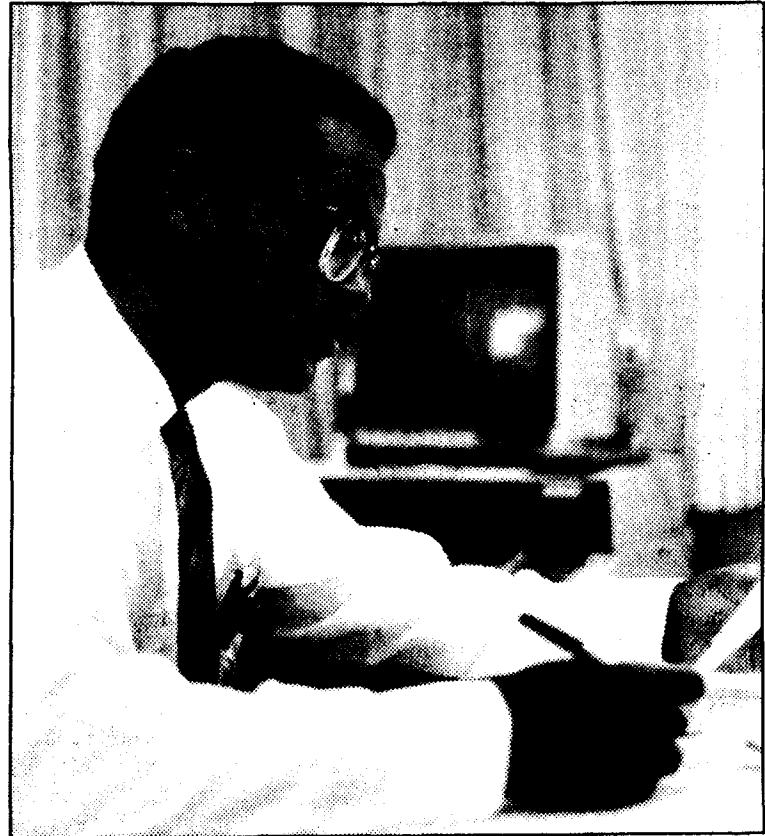
