the world must follow the example of the Soviet Union. "Whole nations of people still believe that peace may be achieved." She also stressed that people must work together to achieve peace.


Since the event began three years ago, this is the first time an in- ground tree has been used.


"We'll use this tree from now on," said Vicky Kholmeyer, chairman of the Lion Ambassadors.
