the 50 states in funding higher education, and Penn State is at the bottom of the state's grant list.

Lilley noted that Penn State "is one of the most efficient research universities in the country. We do the most with the least income dollars."

The final decisions will be made when the Board of Trustees meets later this year.

control the region," said Seelye. He commented on the many myths Arabs have, such as "Syria and Israel are in cahoots" to not wage war.

Speaking about recent Kurdish victories in northern Iraq, Seelye said "Hussein might cut a deal with the Kurds, giving them a share of Iraq's oil revenues to keep them in line."

One of the positive developments from the war is the possibility that American hostages in Lebanon might be released in the next few weeks because of improved American-Iranian relations.

The ambassador spoke for an hour before opening the discussion to questions.

Every year at Easter, St. Mary collects the bundles, and then gives them to prison officials who then distribute them.

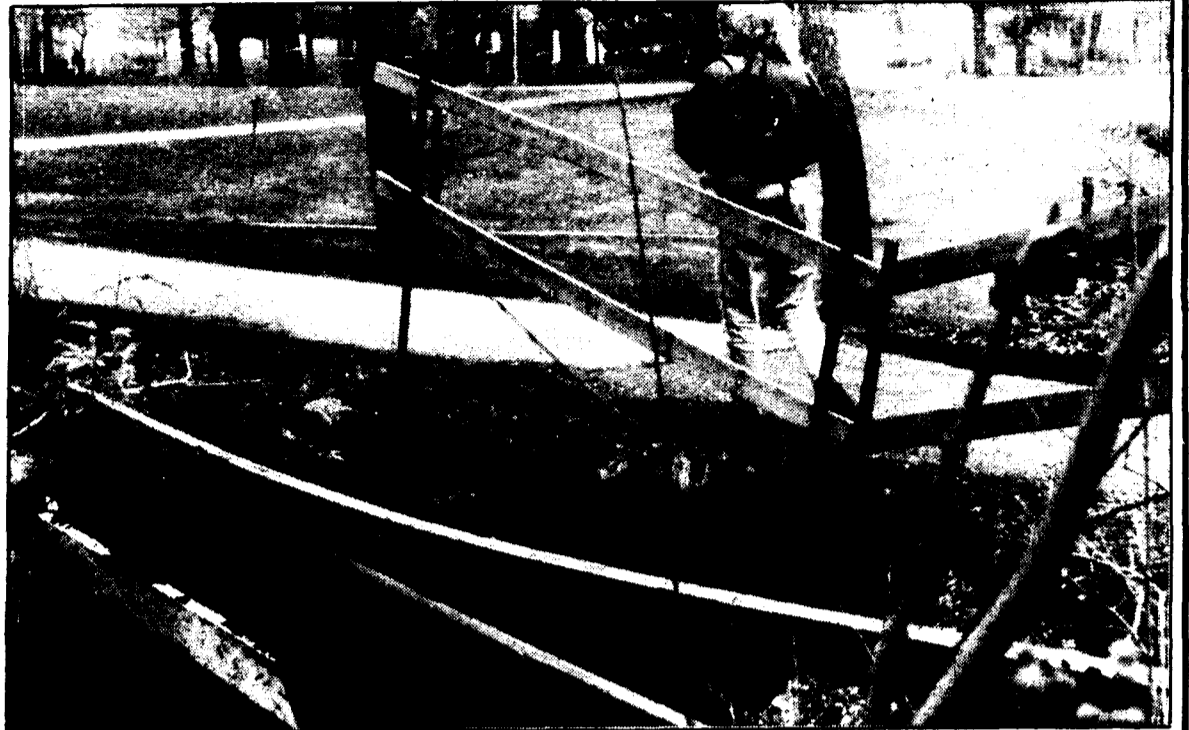
