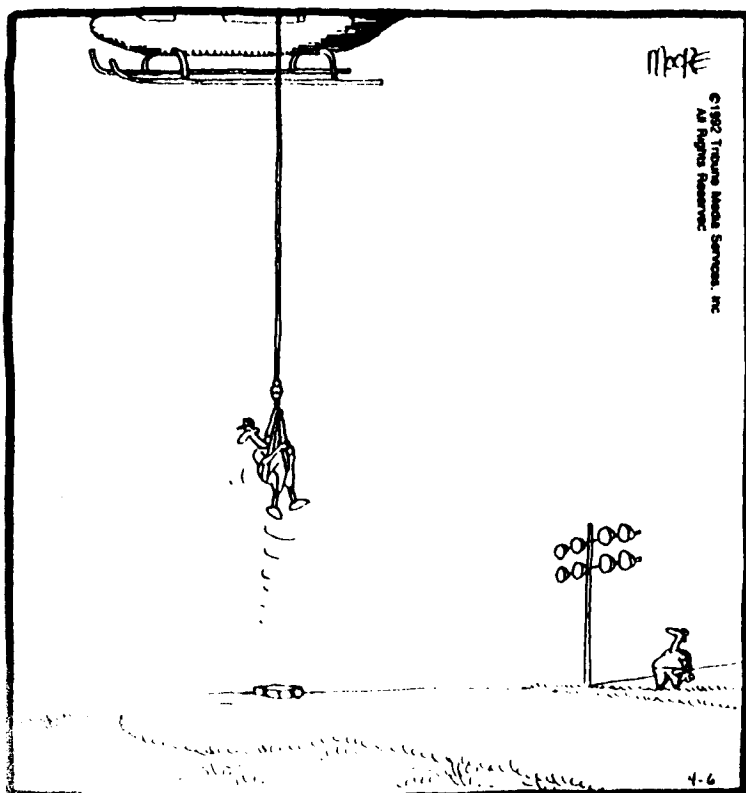
And now for the national news...

The Chicago Bulls beat Milwaukee 116-101 Tuesday night for the franchise record 62nd victory of the season.

The Portland Trailblazers grabbed their second straight Pacific Division title Tuesday night by beating short-handed Golden State 110-101, their second win over the second place Warriors in three nights.

CBS's coverage of the Blue Devils 71-51 triumph was seen in 20.9 million households, topping the 19.8 million which viewed Villanova's 1985 upset of Georgetown. The pro record is 18.8 million for the seventh game of the 1988 NBA finals between the L.A. Lakers and the Detroit Pistons.
