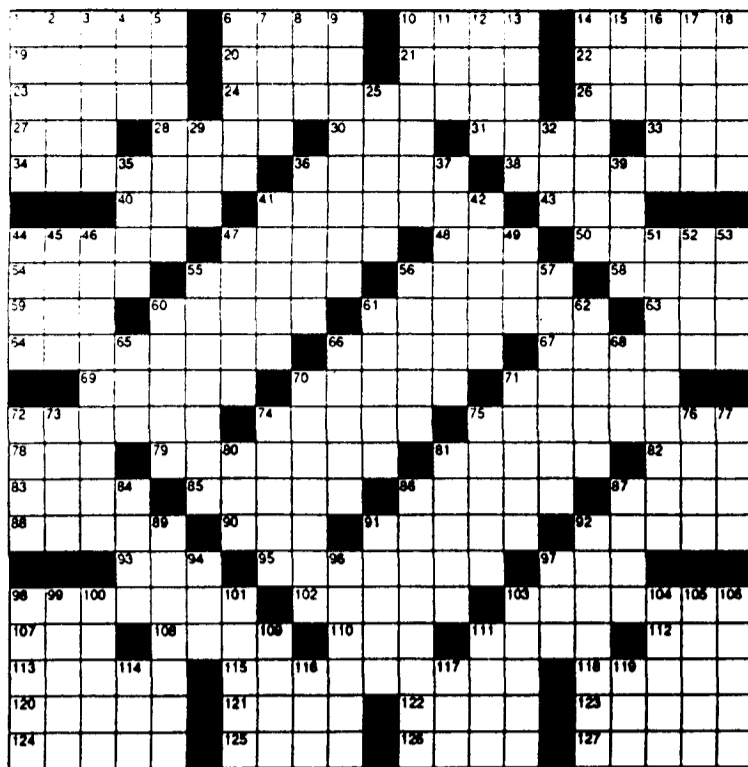

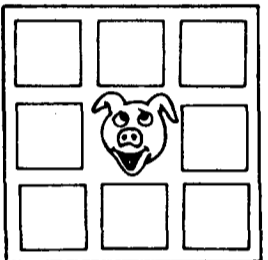
Find at least six differences in details between panels.

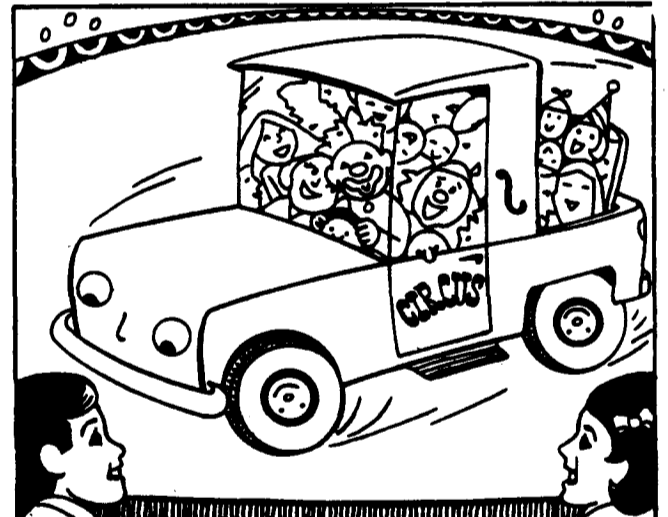
One pig in each corner, four in each center pen, will do it.

FACE LIFT! How many faces do you observe in and about the circus car above? Twenty, 24, as many as 27? Make a count.

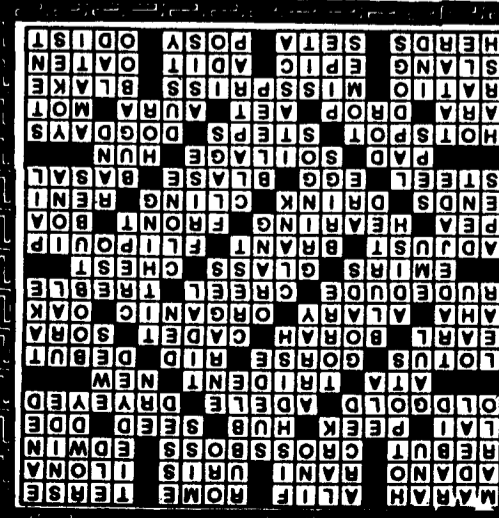
SPELLBINDER
