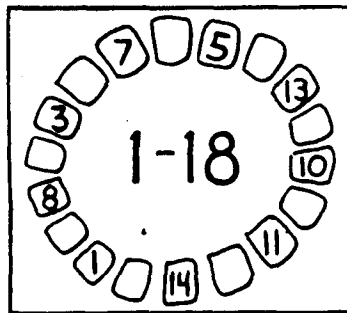

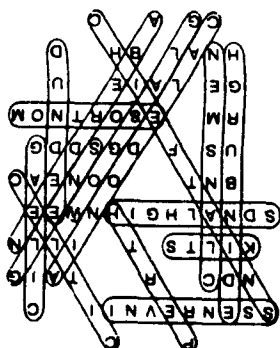

Remember, only threesomes described above are to figure in the count. Time limit: 2 min.

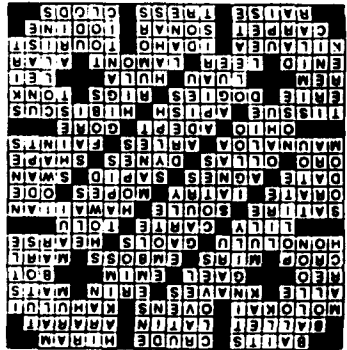


OVER SIGHT! A crowning touch is missing from this school graduation scene. To complete picture, draw dot to dot.
