In this code, then, A becomes Z, B becomes Y, C becomes X, and so on.

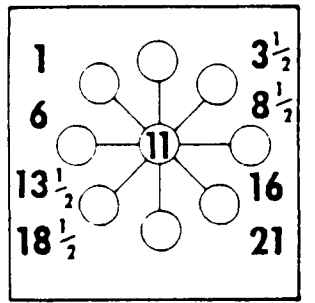
Now see if you can decipher the message at hand. Ironically, it relates to one's decoding ability. Can you puzzle it out?

Object is to insert the amounts shown into the blanks of the figure at right so that each three-number row totals exactly 33.

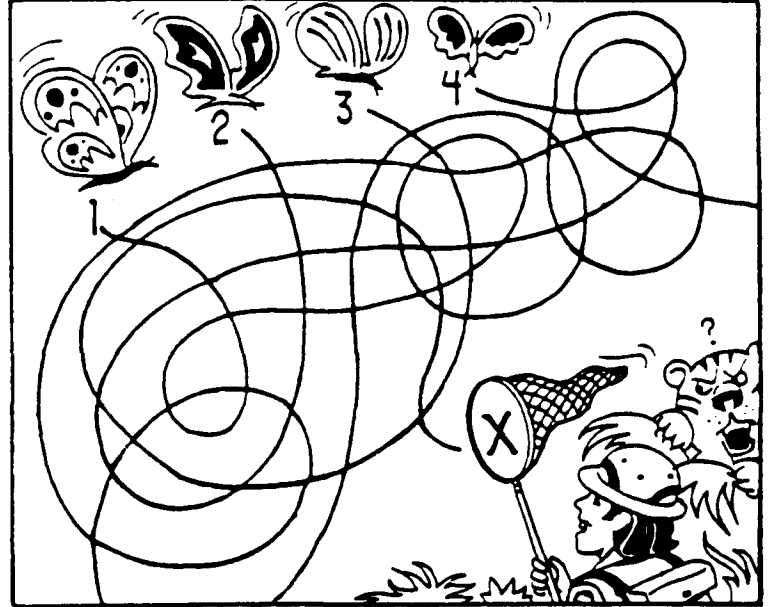
Again, it's a matter of simple addition. See how quickly you can complete the task.
