Divided trackwomen still boast top scores

Women's track head coach Teri Jordan faced a dilemma prior to last weekend: The Lady Lions had the opportunity to compete in the Hoyas Invitational in Washington, D.C., or the Tampa Invitational in Florida.

Eight more would have given her the chance to qualify for the upcoming Eastern College Athletic Conference Regional Championships, and there was even an outside possibility that NCAA qualifying standards would be reached by some individuals.

Jordan's solution to this quandary was a simple one: Lacking advantage of her situation, the Lady Lions were divided into two teams to face each other, sending the most capable athletes to each location. The middle-distance runners and the throwers were assigned to compete in the Hoyas Invitational, while the jumpers, relay teams, and heptathletes participated in Tampa.

"It's not so much that one (location) is less experienced than the other, it's just that the facilities at each (location) are more conducive to those events," Jordan said. Although there were no NCAA qualifying standards achieved over the weekend, several Lady Lions met the standards necessary to qualify for national competition.
